Model 1 - Hybrid Learning

In this model, the teacher delivers a live lesson via Zoom, displayed on the main interactive screen at the front of the classroom. Students follow the lesson together, working with worksheets and notepads at their tables while benefiting from real-time explanation and questioning from the online teacher. An in-class teaching assistant supports learning, facilitates discussion, and helps guide group work, ensuring students remain engaged and supported throughout the lesson.

Model 2 - Enhanced Hybrid Learning

This model builds on the screen-led approach by providing each student with an iPad or learning device, allowing them to see and hear the teacher individually while still learning together in the classroom. In addition to live instruction, students can access shared documents, interactive resources, and online activities that deepen understanding and encourage active participation. Group work and collaboration remain central, with the teacher setting tasks and the in-class assistant supporting students as they work together both offline and online.
